

Author check list

Before uploading your documents into ScholarOne, please check you have included the following information:

- Manuscript is within the journal scope and aligns with one of the article types published by *Public Health Research & Practice*
- Manuscript is formatted as outlined in the journal's [Author Guidelines](#)
- Covering letter contains appropriate author identification and affiliations. You will also be prompted to include an authorship declaration online via ScholarOne, rather than uploading as a separate document
- Conflict of interest declaration completed by each individual author and Licence to publish form signed by the corresponding author (these are available via the journal website: www.phrp.com.au/author-resources/ or can be downloaded from ScholarOne)
- Conflict of interest text statement prepared by the corresponding author if applicable (this should be entered as part of your online manuscript submission via ScholarOne)
- Author details are complete, including names (with middle initials), qualifications, positions, and contact details including email addresses and phone numbers.
- Corresponding author identified in the above list, with email address and phone number
- Authorship statement detailing each author's contribution prepared by corresponding author
- Key points box summarising the key messages of the paper is included (maximum 75 words) apart from Brief Reports
- Figures and images supplied in the appropriate format and attached separately and not in the body of the manuscript text

- Tables and boxes are labelled sequentially and indications are provided throughout the text as to where tables and boxes should appear
- Word count (including abstract, key points and tables) accords with the journal's Author guidelines for the type of article being submitted
- Number of references, graphs, tables and charts accords with Author guidelines
- Pages numbered
- Evidence of ethics approval if relevant
- Appropriate clearances for material received from authors' directors or supervisors
- Copies included of published or in-press articles based on the same research data (please include as separate files)
- Material covered by copyright restrictions that forms part of the submitted work is identified and attributed, and appropriate copyright permissions obtained
- Research articles follow any relevant internationally relevant reporting guidelines (see Author guidelines: www.phrp.com.au/for-authors/author-guidelines-2/)
- Abstracts are supplied in appropriate format depending on the type of article submitted
- Optional completion of the Authorship Inclusivity and Diversity form (available from www.phrp.com.au/author-resources/)
- Track changes and other mark-ups removed (upload track changes and clean version of revised manuscripts)
- Acknowledgements included before the references if needed
- Ensure references have been checked for accuracy
